PURPOSE: To insure proper case reporting in the Record Management System (RMS) when there are multiple drug offenses.

POLICY: The Cleveland Division of Police shall use appropriate state and municipal codes when booking/reporting a drug possession offense and a concurrent Minor Misdemeanor, Possession of Marijuana.

PROCEDURES:

When creating arrest/bookings or case reports, in the RMS, that involve multiple drug offenses the following rule applies.

When using **both** the Ohio Revised Code for a **Drug Possession Offense** and the Cleveland Municipal Code for **Minor Misdemeanor Possession of Marijuana**, the following statutes apply:

ORC 2925.11 (or any subsection there of)

Municipal Code **607.03C3**
