Currently pending before the court in the above-captioned case is Monitor Matthew Barge’s (“Monitor”) Motion Recommending Approval of New Cleveland Division of Police Mission Statement. (ECF No. 72.) The Consent Decree required the Cleveland Division of Police (“CPD”) to develop a new Mission Statement that “reflects its commitment to community oriented policing.” (ECF No. 7-1, at ¶ 28.) After receiving input from CPD officers and organizations, the Community Police Commission, and the wider Cleveland community, the CPD developed the instant proposed Mission Statement (ECF No. 72-1), which the Monitor recommends the court approve. The Monitor also recommends that the CPD replace its current General Police Order 1.1.01 (ECF No. 72-2) with the new Mission Statement and revise its current General Police Order 1.1.02 (ECF No. 72-3), to eliminate the values mission statement paragraph. The court hereby grants the Monitor’s Motion. (ECF No. 72.)
