Cleveland Division of EMS Leads the Way in Public Access Defibrillation and Training

CLEVELAND – The Cleveland Division of Emergency Medical Service (EMS) is pleased to lead the way in public access defibrillation and training. The Division of EMS recently received 75 new Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) and is working to install them. These will replace technologically outdated ones and increase the number of AEDs from 88 to more than 100 throughout City of Cleveland facilities.

As part of the upgrade program, EMS staff will train City of Cleveland employees who work where the defibrillators are deployed to ensure they are comfortable and know how to use them.
