

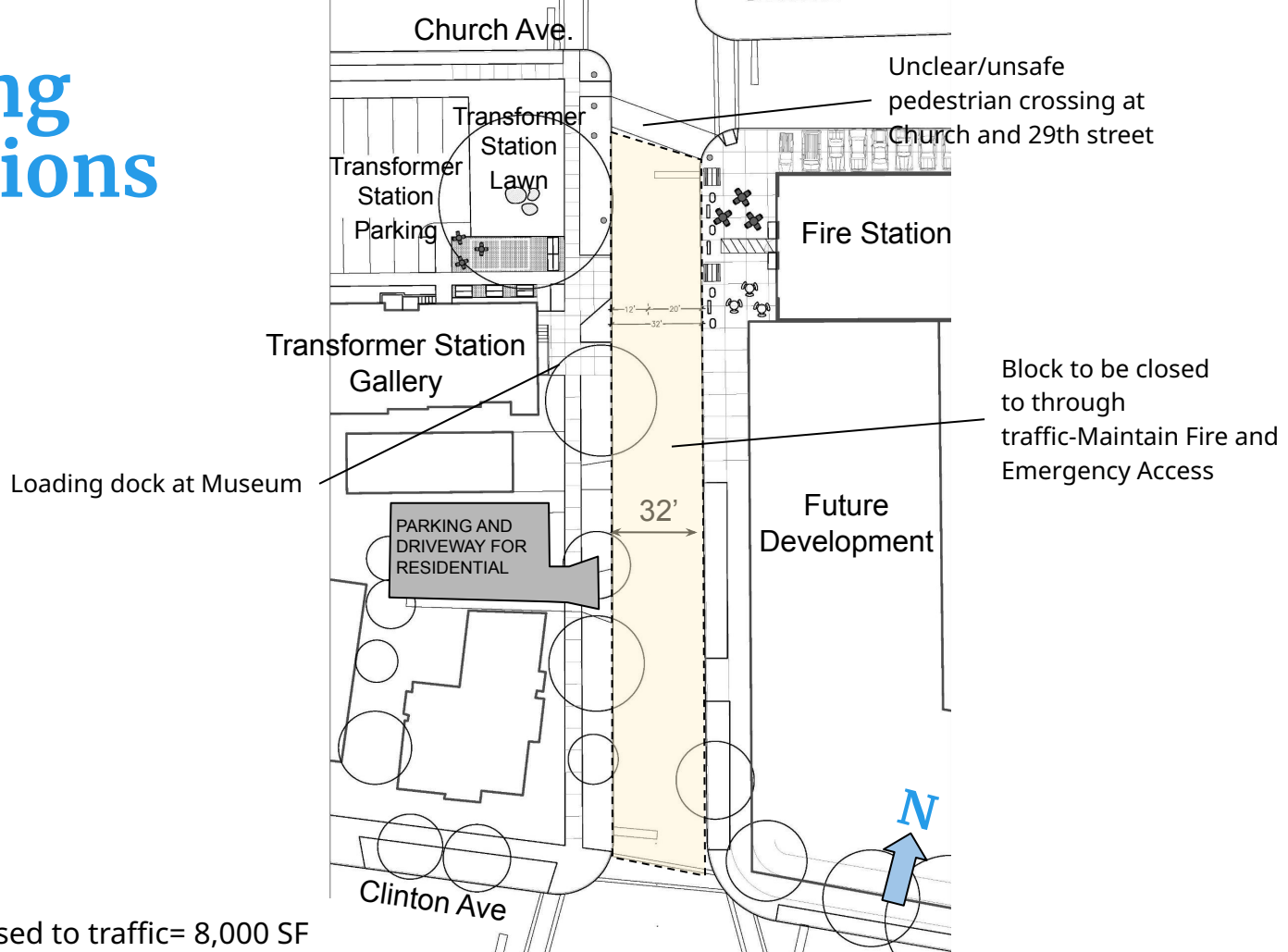

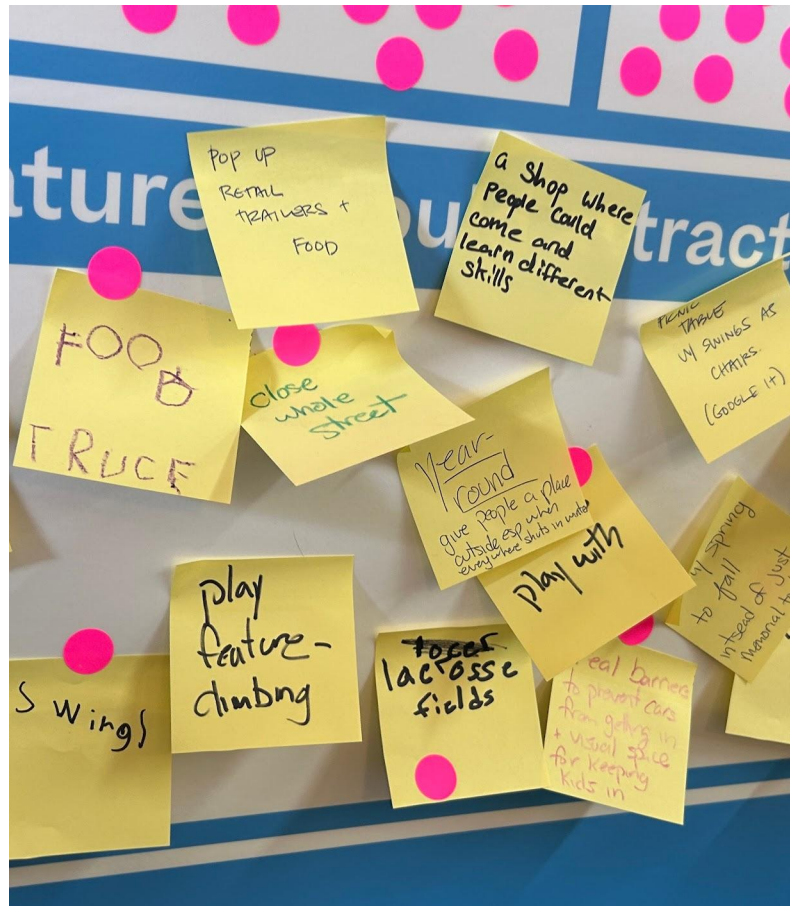
Engagement So Far

Interviews

- 30 total participants so far
 - A focus group of 7 stakeholders and business owners from the immediate block
 - 4 stakeholder meetings with a mix of residents, business owners, and other community members

Workshop

- About 100 community members attended an all-ages open-house style workshop in April at Larder
 - Not counting babies or dogs!
- Participants used stickers to vote for preferences, post-it notes to leave new ideas or provide comments
- Place Evaluation Form with more open ended questions
- Maps for drawing and designing

GRAVEL PATH & STONE BENCHES

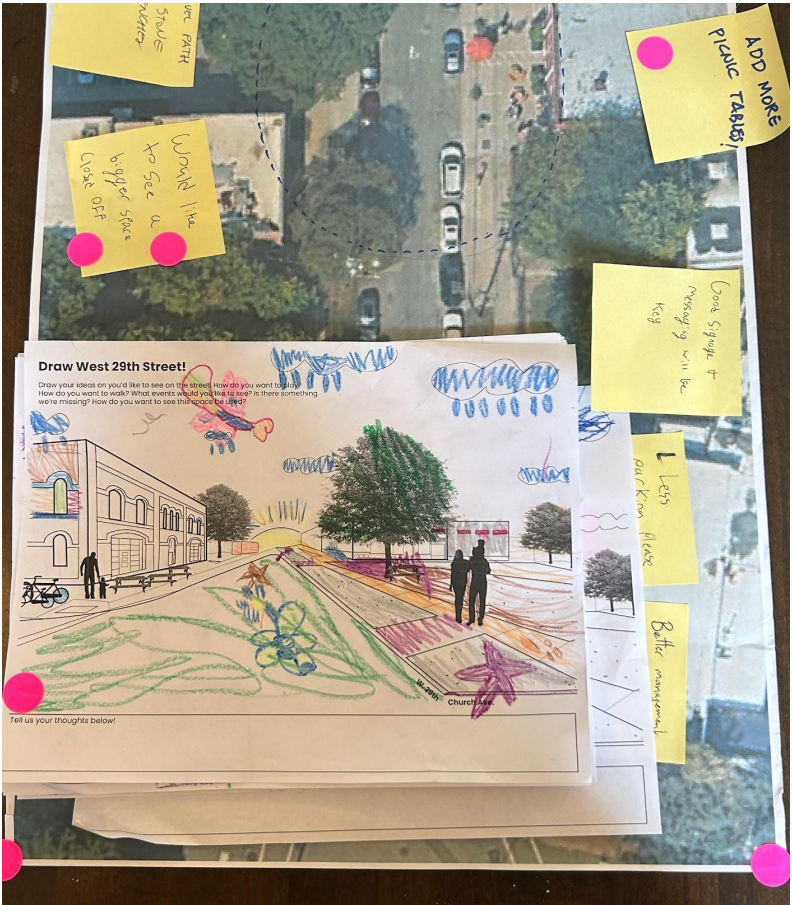
Would like to see a bigger space close off

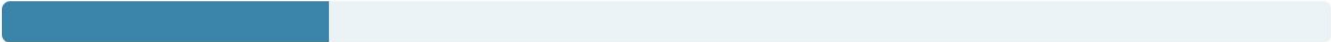
Where do you live from the block of W. 29th between Clinton and Church?

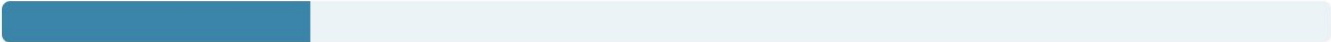
within 2 blocks 50 resp. 35.2%



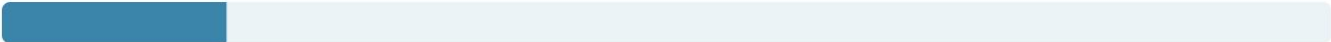
in Ohio City 35 resp. 24.6%

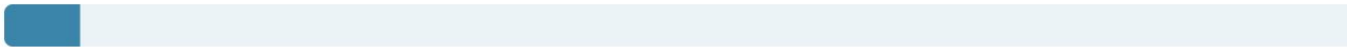

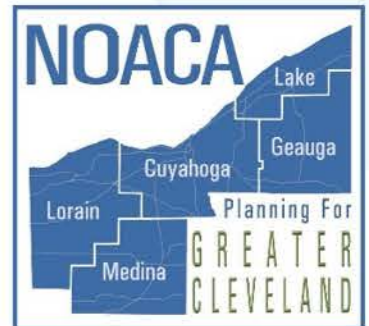

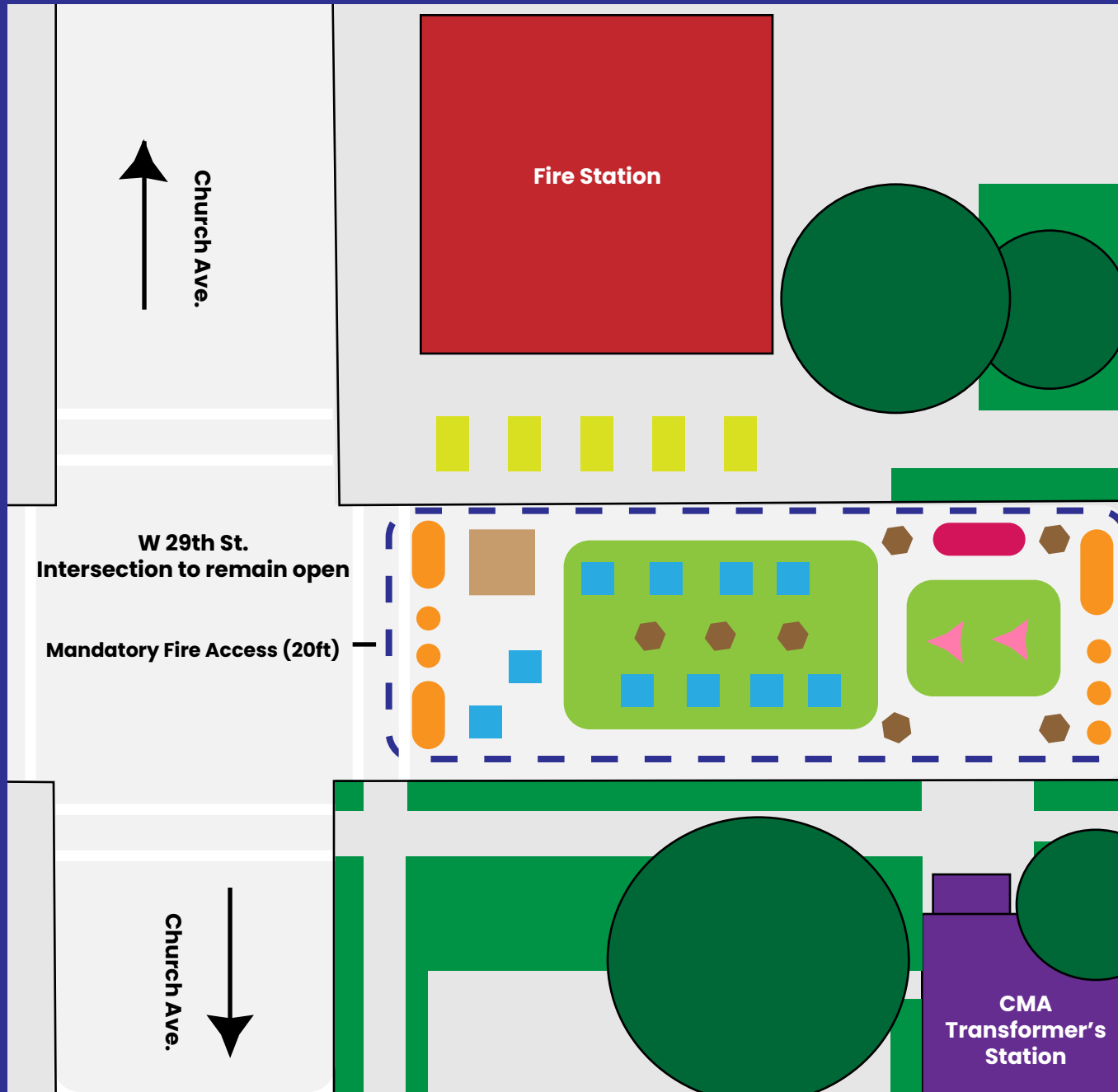
**EXAMPLE OPEN STREET

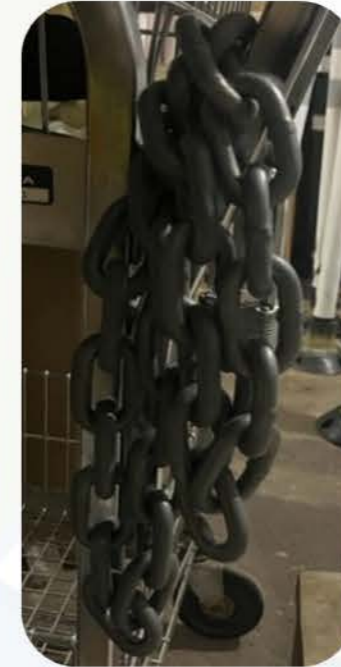
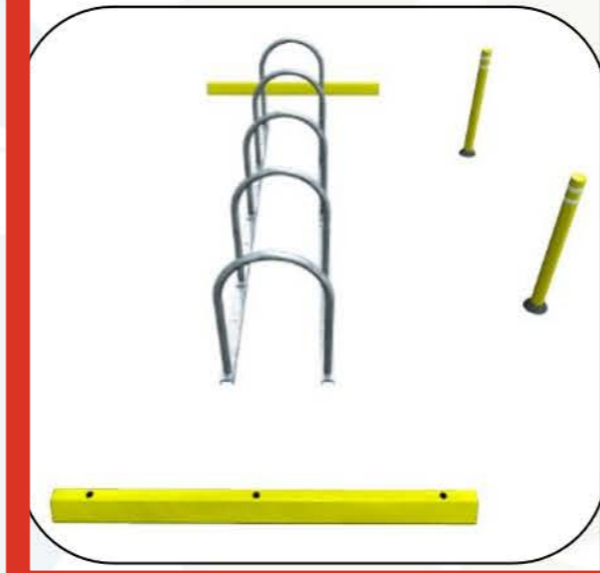
