



As Cleveland's 58th mayor, Justin M. Bibb is dedicated to delivering high-quality city services, modernizing municipal government, and leading transformative change that puts Clevelanders first.

Under Mayor Bibb's leadership, Cleveland has launched groundbreaking initiatives that address critical issues, including the Southeast Side Promise program and a \$100 million initiative to repurpose blighted land into thriving spaces for job creation and community revitalization. His administration has championed public safety through the Raising Investment in Safety for Everyone (RISE) initiative, leveraging strategic investments, community partnerships, and data-driven solutions to reduce crime. Since the launch of RISE, Cleveland saw a 36 percent decrease in homicides, and police recruitment reached its highest level since before the pandemic.

Housing equity is a cornerstone of Mayor Bibb's vision. The Home for Every Neighbor initiative has placed over 100 unsheltered residents in permanent housing, while the Residents First agenda protects Clevelanders from predatory landlords. Collaborating with City Council and private sector partners, his administration has launched a \$100 million housing investment fund to expand affordable housing for working families.

Mayor Bibb has prioritized reconnecting Cleveland to its waterfronts, securing over \$150 million in state and federal funding to transform the Lake Erie shoreline. With input from over 5,000 residents, the city's lakefront master plan aims to enhance access, spur economic growth, and promote environmental stewardship. Cleveland's dual waterfronts represent transformative opportunities and Mayor Bibb's \$5 billion Shore-to-Core-to-Shore initiative is reshaping the city center and the Cuyahoga Riverfront with historic public-private partnerships and investments.



Beyond Cleveland, Mayor Bibb serves as vice president of the Democratic Mayors Association, advocating for transformative urban policies nationwide. As co-chair of Mayors Against Illegal Guns, he is a leading voice in the fight to end gun violence through common-sense legislation and community strategies. His commitment to sustainability and climate action is reflected in his role as co-chair of America is All In and as chair emeritus of the bipartisan Climate Mayors network.

Mayor Bibb's career began in public service, working for President Barack Obama during his tenure in the U.S. Senate. He later served as an education and economic policy advisor for Cuyahoga County. Outside government, he held leadership roles at Gallup, KeyBank, and Urbanova, where he focused on improving urban life through innovation.

A native of the Mt. Pleasant neighborhood, Mayor Bibb is a proud graduate of American University with a degree in Urban Studies. He pursued advanced studies in social policy and economics at the London School of Economics and earned both a Master of Business Administration (MBA) and a Juris Doctor (JD) from Case Western Reserve University.

Mayor Bibb continues to champion Cleveland's resurgence through bold leadership, innovative solutions, and an unwavering commitment to equity and inclusion.
