Intent to Apply for the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's Preservation and Reinvestment Initiative for Community Enhancement (PRICE) Main Program

The City of Cleveland Department of Community Development is publicly noticing its intent to apply for funding through the Preservation and Reinvestment Initiative for Community Enhancement Main Program made available through the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development. Cleveland's application will be submitted with program outcomes along with potential partners. This initiative, if funded, proposes to allow the City to (1) update its 2030 Housing Plan to incorporate manufactured and modular housing into its zoning and planning efforts for affordable housing opportunities and tenant protections; (2) develop modular housing manufacturing jobs within the City of Cleveland; and (3) provide loan guarantees for up to 300 units of multi-family and high-density single-family modular housing on City land bank lots within high access areas to transit and amenities.
