## Hessler Court Wooden Brick Restoration Project Traffic Advisory Hessler Road to Bellflower Road Monday, July 15th, 2024 (Ward 6)

**CLEVELAND** – During the week of July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024, weather permitting, the City will begin wood brick restoration of Hessler Court from Hessler Road to Bellflower Road. A complete closure of Hessler Court is expected to occur. On street parking for Hessler Road will not be effected by the work being performed on Hessler Court.

The project will remove the existing wood bricks and replace with new wood bricks, replace sandstone sidewalk and curbs, drill weep holes for drainage, install new catch basins, and ADA complaint curb ramps. The work will take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m, Monday through Friday. The brick restoration project is expected to be completed by the end of August 2024.
