## **Pipeline Infrastructure Improvements Update**

### **Enbridge Gas Ohio - Pipeline Infrastructure Replacement Project**

#### **PIR 3489 – Parkside Road and Thorn Avenue**

#### **(City of Cleveland - Ward 9)**

**CLEVELAND** – On Monday, January 6, 2025, an Enbridge Gas Ohio pipeline infrastructure replacement project will begin on the following streets:

- East Boulevard – East side from Herrick Road to Shakespeare Parkway
- Parkside Road – From Shakespeare Avenue to Parkgate Avenue
- East 97<sup>th</sup> Street – From Shakespeare Avenue to Parkgate Avenue
- East 99<sup>th</sup> Street – From North Boulevard to Adams Avenue
- Thorn Avenue – From Parkside Road to East 97<sup>th</sup> Street
- Parkgate Avenue – From East 92<sup>nd</sup> Street to East 98<sup>th</sup> Street
- Pierpont Avenue – From East 92<sup>nd</sup> Street to East 99<sup>th</sup> Street
- Adams Avenue - From East 92<sup>nd</sup> Street to East 99<sup>th</sup> Street

The improvements include replacing the old steel mainline with a new plastic mainline in the roadway and sidewalk area. A work zone will be established which will allow two-way traffic with traffic control personnel present to help direct traffic flow. Access to adjacent driveways and businesses will be maintained throughout construction. Work will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

This project is scheduled for completion in May 2025. Should the weather not allow for permanent restoration to the sidewalk and roadway after construction. A temporary 2” thick concrete sidewalk will be installed for pedestrian traffic, and concrete road caps will be placed on all road crossings until permanent restorations can be completed in the spring of 2025.

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**Enbridge Gas Ohio - Pipeline Infrastructure Replacement Project**  
**PIR 3860 – West 65<sup>th</sup> Street**  
**(City of Cleveland - Ward 14)**

**CLEVELAND** – On Monday, January 6, 2025, an Enbridge Gas Ohio pipeline infrastructure replacement project will begin on the following street:

- West 65<sup>th</sup> Street – From Denison Avenue to Storer Avenue

The improvement includes replacing the old steel mainline with a new plastic mainline in the roadway and sidewalk area. A work zone will be established which will allow two-way traffic with traffic control personnel present to help direct traffic flow. Access to adjacent driveways and businesses will be maintained throughout construction. Work will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

This project is scheduled for completion in March 2025. Should the weather not allow for permanent restoration to the sidewalk and roadway after construction. A temporary 2” thick concrete sidewalk will be installed for pedestrian traffic, and concrete road caps will be placed on all road crossings until permanent restorations can be completed in Spring 2025.

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**Enbridge Gas Ohio - Pipeline Infrastructure Replacement Project  
PIR 3804 – Woburn Avenue & West 62<sup>nd</sup> Street  
(City of Cleveland - Ward 13)**

**CLEVELAND** – On Monday, January 20, 2025, an Enbridge Gas Ohio pipeline infrastructure replacement project will begin on the following streets:

- West 48<sup>th</sup> Street – Memphis Ave to Woburn Ave
- West 49<sup>th</sup> Street – Memphis Ave to Woburn Ave
- West 49<sup>th</sup> Street – Woburn to Ardmore Ave East side only
- West 50<sup>th</sup> Street - Memphis Ave to Woburn Ave
- West 52<sup>nd</sup> Street - Memphis Ave to Gifford Ave
- Ardmore Avenue – South side West 49<sup>th</sup> Street to West 48<sup>th</sup> Street

The improvements include replacing the old steel mainline with a new plastic mainline in the roadway and sidewalk area. A work zone will be established which will allow two-way traffic with traffic control personnel present to help direct traffic flow. Access to adjacent driveways and businesses will be maintained throughout construction. Work will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

#### **PIR 3655 – Aetna Avenue & East 74<sup>th</sup> Street**

#### **(City of Cleveland - Ward 12)**

**CLEVELAND** – On Monday, January 27, 2025, an Enbridge Gas Ohio pipeline infrastructure replacement project will begin on the following streets:

- Aetna Avenue – From Fleet Avenue to Broadway Avenue
- East 72 St – East side from Aetna Avenue to Union Avenue
- East 74 St – East side from Aetna Avenue to Union Avenue

The improvements include replacing the old steel mainline with a new plastic mainline in the roadway and sidewalk area. A work zone will be established which will allow two-way traffic with traffic control personnel present to help direct traffic flow. Access to adjacent driveways and businesses will be maintained throughout construction. Work will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
