

• "It was the intention of our office to bid this project as a requirements contract. It came to our attention that requirements contracts are bid at 20% CSB, is this correct? The project is being bid Public Improvements by Requirement and we bid the project at 30% CSB. Can your office clarify if 20% or 30% must be fulfilled for OEO requirements?"

ANSWER

"The 30% CSB goal is correct, as this project includes construction. A 20% CSB goal would apply to strict commodities purchases and other non-professional services. The 30% CSB goal should remain in effect."

"The contract is bid with base bid items that show minimum quantities within the schedule of items. The contractors who attended the pre-bid meeting were concerned with the realization that quantities for the base bid items could change during the contract duration thus altering the OEO schedules and CSB participation. With a min. of 30% participation, do you recommend how a potential bidder should move forward with the bid of this project with temperamental OEO participation goals versus the distribution of potential quantities?"

ANSWER


"While this is an indeterminate quantity bid, Bidders should still complete the OEO schedules and document the use of certified CSB subcontractors in an effort to meet the goal. Subcontractors should have actual value in dollars for the subcontract on Schedule 2.

OEO will evaluate the subcontracting commitments in dollars as a percentage of the final total bid price to determine whether the bidder met the subcontracting goal.

Where the bidder cannot meet the subcontracting goal, the bidder should provide an explanation for this deficiency along with the Schedule 4 to demonstrate the Bidder's good faith effort to meet the goal. OEO will evaluate all subcontractor commitments and good faith effort documentation.

In the event that the indeterminate quantity of the bid impacts a subcontractor's actual participation on the project, OEO will adjust subcontracting commitments to reflect the change in expected quantity or scope. Bidders are advised to make careful and accurate subcontractor commitments, but OEO will not hold a bidder responsible for changes to a subcontractor's participation on the project that is outside of the Bidder's control."
