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## INFORMATION & ASSISTANCE

An **Information and Assistance Specialist** can assist with identifying your needs and preferences, provide current and unbiased information on services that support independence and link you to organizations that can help.

## OPTIONS COUNSELING

An **Options Counselor** is available to talk with you, your family members, caregivers and/or significant others about community services and support to fit your needs and preferences and to guide you through what can be a difficult and complicated decision making process.

## BENEFITS ASSISTANCE

A **Benefits Specialist** can screen for your eligibility for public benefits and guide you through the application process.
