## **Clark Avenue Streetscape Project**

**West 41<sup>st</sup> Street to Quigley Road  
(City of Cleveland - Wards 3, 12 & 14)**

**Expect additional traffic notices as improvements continue**

**CLEVELAND** – On February 19, 2020, the City of Cleveland will begin Phase 2 of the Clark Avenue Rehabilitation Project (West 41<sup>st</sup> Street to Quigley Road). Phase 2 construction will take place between West 41<sup>st</sup> Street and West 25<sup>th</sup> Street, with work on the south side of the road.

Maintenance of traffic will be as follows:

- One-way, eastbound traffic will be maintained on the north side of Clark Avenue between West 41<sup>st</sup> Street and West 25<sup>th</sup> Street
- Westbound motorists will be detoured south on West 25<sup>th</sup> Street to I-71 southbound entrance ramp; then south on I-71 to Fulton Road; then north on Fulton Road to West 41<sup>st</sup> Street; then north on West 41<sup>st</sup> Street to Clark Avenue. Access at all intersections and driveways will be maintained, but on-street parking will not be permitted.

Electronic message boards were placed on either end of the Phase 2 construction on January 24, 2020 informing the public of the impending construction work.

The Clark Avenue construction is being administered by the Ohio Department of Transportation. Improvements include:

- Milling and asphalt resurfacing
- Full depth and partial depth pavement repairs
- Curb and walk replacements as needed
- Replacement of curb ramps to bring them into compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act
- New 12-inch water main between West 41<sup>st</sup> Street and West 25<sup>th</sup> Street

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- New 8-inch water main between West 25<sup>th</sup> Street and Quigley Road
- And new landscape/streetscape elements including banners

A traffic signal at the south leg of West 32<sup>nd</sup> Street will be removed. New mast arm traffic signals will be installed at the north leg of West 32<sup>nd</sup> Street, Scranton Avenue, West 16<sup>th</sup> Street and West 14<sup>th</sup> Street and pedestrian crossings will be updated at other intersections. New pavement markings and signage will include dedicated bike facilities and on-street parking. The work on this project will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Construction is scheduled to be completed by the end of October 2020.
