**East 105<sup>th</sup> Street Rehabilitation Project**  
**Traffic Advisory**  
**East Boulevard Reconstruction at East 105<sup>th</sup> Street**  
**Monday, March 16, 2020**  
**(Ward 9)**

**Expect additional traffic notices as improvements continue**

**CLEVELAND** – On Monday, March 16, 2020, as part of the City’s East 105<sup>th</sup> Street Rehabilitation Project, the City will begin work on East Boulevard at East 105<sup>th</sup> Street. This work will include the realignment and reconstruction of the East Boulevard approach to East 105<sup>th</sup> Street. East Boulevard will be closed to all traffic at the intersection of East 105<sup>th</sup> Street, but open to local traffic at the intersection of Wade Park Avenue. Traffic moving on East Boulevard north of Wade Park Avenue is not affected.

Maintenance of traffic will be as follows:

- Local traffic on East Boulevard from Wade Park Avenue will be maintained at all times.
- All traffic intending to proceed west on East Boulevard from East 105<sup>th</sup> Street will be detoured west on Wade Park Avenue and then south on East Boulevard.
- Traffic control patterns north of Wade Park Avenue will remain in place.

The work will take place during the hours of 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. The East Boulevard portion of the project is scheduled for completion in May 2020.
